

#### A. Embark on a mangrove tour

Explore the spectacular wetlands of the island via boat cruising, guided by the local certified nature guides. Experience the panoramic view of the island and if you are lucky you might be able to watch some migratory birds. You will also learn how the locals depend on the fishery as their source of income as well as get your hands dirty to plant the mangrove saplings and sow the seedlings.





B. Village tour

Immerse yourself in the local culture by experience it. Enjoy the local cuisine "asam pedas" and "nasi lemak daun simpuh" and learn the techniques of preparing delicacies from the locals. Wander around the villages and enjoy learning handicraft making, preparation of Acanthus leaves tea products, kelulut honey farming, traditional Jong game and many other cottage industries by the locals.



#### C. Experience fishing like a local

Discover "reel" connections fishing at the island with the local fishermen. The recreational fishing is aimed at casual fishermen or die-hard anglers. You can also request to cook the caught fishes according to the local recipes.

Tanjung Surat Asland


The island is a home to 418 people of 112 families from three different villages: Linting Village, Tanjung Surat Village and Nyior Village. The island is a remote area far from the town, making it a perfect gateway from hustle and bustle of the city centre. Many still do not know about the uniqueness of Tanjung Surat Island surrounded by the diversity of mangrove species, the habitat of various flora and fauna including marine life.

Tanjung Sulat mangloves

Tanjung Surat is one of the sub-districts in Kota Tinggi. In this area, there is Tanjung Surat Island located next to the Belungkor Forest Reserve on the southeastern side of the Johor River. The mangrove forest of Tanjung Surat Island is one of the best forests along the Johor River that is home to many species of flora and fauna, evergreen dense mangrove species and pollutant-free healthy ecosystem. Although isolated, the island of Tanjung Surat offers unique nature of the priceless mangrove forest.







For local or internal tourists, the main transportation to Tanjung Surat Island is by using local boat services or pontoon services. If you are from Singapore or Batam Indonesia, can use ferry service of Tanjung Belungkor Terminal Ferry: <u>www.limbonganmaju.com</u>.

Pontoon services are also provided to bring in vehicles from outside. The Tanjung Surat Island locals live modestly, dependent on the surrounding ecosystem with basic amenities such as a mosque, a primary school, a village clinic and a local fisherman jetty.
