

REHABILITATION OF PEAT SWAMP FOREST PROGRAMME WITH THE INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY IN SOUTHEAST PAHANG PEATLAND LANDSCAPE

MISSION

- To implement peatland rehabilitation and fire control activities with the Indigenous Community
- To empower the Indigenous Community through education and awareness

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To enhance the rehabilitation effort by improving the hydrological system of the effected peatland area
- 2. To implement enrichment planting activities at the degraded peatland area
- 3. To implement peatland fire prevention measures through establishment of a community-led patrol team

PEAT SWAMP FOREST REHABILITATION EFFORT

1. RE-WETTING OF DEGRADED PEATLAND THROUGH WATER MANAGEMENT

The installation of canal blocks at abandoned drainages from the previous logging activities helps to increase water level as well as contribute to the re-wetting of the degraded peatland areas. The peatland re-wetting effort is implemented by installing a total of 10 canal blocks thus far with contribution and involvement of stakeholders for the landscape.





2. ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY AT DEGRADED PEATLAND AREA WITH THE LOCAL COMMUNITY

Enrichment activity is implemented to accelerate natural succession of the parent trees at degraded peatland area after re-wetting. This activity is conducted with the local community. Maintenance activity such as circle weeding is an ongoing exercise to increase the survival rate of the planted trees.

3. ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY-BASED PEAT FIRE PATROLING TEAM

Peat fire patrolling team consists of 2 members of Friends of Peat Swamp Forest Kampung Tanjung Kelapa. They are assigned to patrol fire-prone areas and measure as well as monitor the water level readings at each canal block.

4-A. STRAW MUSHROOM

Straw mushroom farming helps to generate extra source of income amongst the local community as well as provide source of food.



4-C. MENGKUANG WEAVING

Local communities weave the mengkuang leaves into a handicraft to sell around the village.

4-B. KELULUT HONEY

Kelulut honey farming can generate source of income through sales and increases fruit yields.



4-D. ESTABLISHEMENT OF COMMUNITY NURSERY

Nursing of *Mahang* tree saplings as a part of the rehabilitation programme.
